Robert and Gina, the hotel owners, have chosen a selection of wines that are personal favourites of theirs. These wines encompass a diversity of style and provenance, we hope you enjoy them.

## Sparkling

- 7 NV Pol Roger, Brut Réserve FRANCE 90  
Brut Réserve is never sold until the youngest component is a minimum of 3 years old. This additional maturity contributes much to the reputation Brut Réserve ('White Foil') enjoys. Generally, Brut Réserve contains the wines of at least two vintages, often three or four.

## White

- 33 2024 Sauvignon Blanc, Origin, Saint Clair MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND 45  
Fruit was sourced from a selection of vineyards located predominantly in the lower Wairau sub-region. This is what Saint Clair regards as Marlborough's best subregion for Sauvignon Blanc, producing wines with heightened expression. A herbaceous, crisp wine showing intense flavours of ripe gooseberry and pear over a creamy texture.
- 26 2024 Sancerre, J. de Villebois LOIRE, FRANCE 66  
A textured and richly flavoured Sancerre with intense herbaceous and citrus aromas, balanced by a vibrant and refreshing, crisp palate. A delightful drop.
- 25 2024 Chablis, Domaine Grand Roche BURGUNDY, FRANCE 64  
Chablis is internationally renowned for the combination of the Chardonnay grape and the Kimmeridgian soils in which they are cultivated. These estate vineyards are no exception, the limestone soils impart 'mineral' characteristics, elegance and finesse to the resulting wine. Fresh, bright aromas of citrus fruit and floral notes are elegantly enveloped in subtle, smoky mineral notes.
- 38 2024 Chardonnay, Village, Yering Station YARRA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA 49  
Yering were at the forefront of the wine industry in Australia, in fact they planted the first ever grapes in Victoria back in 1838. It's safe to say they know what they are doing! This cool climate Chardonnay delivers white peach with attractive struck match and the oak just plays a supporting role.
- 39 2024 Pouilly-Fuissé 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Prestige, Domaine Ferrand BURGUNDY, FRANCE 85  
There's no surprises here, this is top Chardonnay from the hallowed turf of Burgundy which tastes just how you'd want it to. Unapologetically rich and buttery with exotic fruit and a lick of vanilla. It's hard to find good value in Burgundy these days but the Mâconnais does just that.

## Red

- 86 2015 Château Preuillac, Cru Bourgeois, Médoc BORDEAUX, FRANCE 62  
Cru Bourgeois are Médoc châteaux that produce wines of typicity and quality but generally without the breed of their aristocratic cousins from the 1855 Classification. One of the original Cru Bourgeois named in 1932, this Merlot dominant interpretation has ripe red berry flavours with distinctive savoury notes.
- 75 2021 Ribera del Duero Crianza, Resalte de Peñafiel RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN 64  
For many, Ribera del Duero is the King of Spanish Reds. Unlike Rioja they use French oak, and not American, this produces more subtle oak flavours and silkier tannins. This is a deeply complex wine, pronounced dark berry fruit, a touch of liquorice, and exquisitely integrated oak.
- 87 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso d'Oro CALIFORNIA, USA 72  
Smooth and delicious, the opulent palate is bursting with black cherry, cassis and chocolate through to an elegant and sustained finish.
- 89 2020 Château de Valois, Pomerol  BORDEAUX, FRANCE 88  
Pomerol is a democracy that stands apart from the rest of Bordeaux. It has no classification system but has still risen to the top of the tree thanks to the likes of Pétrus and Le Pin. Château de Valois dates back to 1862 when the prestigious vineyards of Château Figeac were restructured. This is a rich, generous textured wine with marked freshness and lots of spice.
- 76 2019 Rioja Reserva, Viña Ardanza, La Rioja Alta RIOJA, SPAIN 87  
La Rioja Alta are the kings of Spain and their Rioja's are renowned the world over. The Ardanza has some lovely age which delivers exquisite balance, silkiness and opulence. When you taste their wines you never forget them.
